

# Blessing for Wedding Shower:

\_\_\_\_\_, It is my privilege to be here today to bring you this blessing. I have so many memories of you growing up (or something else that is relevant); and it is delightful to be here today to celebrate your upcoming wedding.

One of the things I've learned recently is just how much God wants to bless us. In fact, if we understand that what God does in the Old Testament through the families in Genesis is what he wants to do for us today; we discover that God went out of his way to bless Abraham, and despite impossible odds, to fulfill his promises.

Genesis 12 states: "Abram, I will make you into a great nation. I will bless you and make you famous, and you will be a blessing to others." Sometime later, the Lord took Abram outside and said to him, "Look up into the sky and count the stars if you can. That's how many descendents you will have." God also described a territory of land for Abraham that he was to receive as his inheritance. We can discern from Abraham, the father of faith, that God gave him two parts to his inheritance: descendents and land.

It's easy to discern what the descendents represent: children and heirs. But, what does land represent to us today? Land represents our destiny....the territory that God designed for us since before the beginning of the universe. If you put these two things together, along with the blessings God gave Abraham, we discover that God has a destiny for us to live out, for our lifetime, but even more for us to pass the blessings God gives us onto our descendents for generations to come. Scripture even tells us that God will bless our descendents for a 1,000 generations! That's a very long time.

I've been reflecting on the generational blessings I've observed in your family, \_\_\_\_\_Bride. Suggestions: (feel free to add or subtract)

I see two parents who love one another and have committed themselves to raise a family whose first priority is the Lord. I see a family that gathers to celebrate and goes out of their way to give blessings in the big and small areas of life. I see a family that is close and connected and full of blessing.

Groom (create what's relevant here), I heard her observe many of the same priorities in his family: a committed loving marriage, a family of faith, people who celebrate and put a priority on family.

To be able to be here with a solid foundation coming from both sides: the bride and the groom shows me that God has very big plans for \_\_\_\_\_\_bride and groom.

He has blessed you so that the two of you in your marriage can not only continue to carry out those blessings but to discover the specific way that God wants you to be a blessing to the world and to those who will follow you.

My prayer for you:

Jeremiah 32:37-41:

I will bring them back to this very city and let them live in peace and safety. 38 They will be my people, and I will be their God. 39 And I will give them one heart and one purpose: to worship me forever, for their own good and for the good of all their descendants. 40 And I will make an everlasting covenant with them: I will never stop doing good for them. I will put a desire in their hearts to worship me, and they will never leave me. 41 I will find joy doing good for them and will faithfully and wholeheartedly replant them in this land.

If desired and available, it is a gift to invite significant people in the bride's' life to also bless:

Grandmother, mother, mentor, sister, mother in law, etc. This demonstrates the blessing passing through the different generations.

# **Blessing for Marriage:**

#### Genesis 2:16-25:

God took the Man and set him down in the Garden of Eden to work the ground and keep it in order. God commanded the Man, "You can eat from any tree in the garden, except from the Tree-of-Knowledge-of-Good-and-Evil. Don't eat from it. The moment you eat from that tree, you're dead."

God said, "It's not good for the Man to be alone; I'll make him a helper, a companion." So God formed from the dirt of the ground all the animals of the field and all the birds of the air. He brought them to the Man to see what he would name them. Whatever the Man called each living creature, that was its name. We know that God delights in families having babies as his original mandate to us in Genesis 1:28 states: "Then God blessed them and said, 'Be fruitful and multiply!" Babies are one of God's favorite creations....He's dreamed about each one before the beginning of the universe and can't wait to see them live out the many good gifts he designed them to experience!

We also know that God loves to give big welcomes to newborn babies by the party he gave Jesus....the whole sky lit up and the radiance of the glory of the Lord surrounded the shepherds, while a vast host of angels announced his birth!

We want to give your baby a big welcome to the world too! Babies in the womb perceive much more than I ever realized...and when we speak blessings over them while they are developing in the womb, it gives them the ability to adapt and thrive when they are born. Knowing they are loved is like 100 million dollars in the bank!

As you look around, you see your name specific people that have important roles in the babies life, such as grandmother, aunt, sister, etc. and many other lifelong friends and family that have woven the fabric of your life.

What we can't see as easily are the angels gathered around you, (mother's name), who are also celebrating with us...because Heaven is rejoicing in the life of your sweet baby...the one whom Heaven has great plans for. God has blessed you abundantly,, and he is passing his blessing through you to your baby, as well as the people who are going to be influential and important in his/her life.

# **Blessing for Empty Nesting:**

Consider doing something very special to recognize and celebrate reaching the status of empty nesting. Empty nesting is often accompanied by grief of children leaving home, an emptiness of activity and loss of the important role of parent. But, in the absence, the idea is to rediscover your spouse in ways that time, energy and often finances didn't permit in the early years.

Ideas for recognizing and blessing empty nesting:

- Invite your friends and family to a set apart time for you to acknowledge your new role, to hear your losses, but also your new dreams, and to pray for you and your spouse as you start this very new season in your lives. Consider making the pledge below to one another with your friends and family as witnesses.
- Go on a romantic trip (perhaps place of honeymoon or a long dreamed for experience)
- Brainstorm a new activity that you do together and prioritize time in your schedule to do it regularly.
- Write love letters to one another where you share your dreams for your new season.

# Blessing for Senior Years/Wisdom:

Giving honor to our seniors brings great joy to God and a blessing to us:

Exodus 20:12: Honor your father and mother so you will live a long time in the land the Lord your God is giving to you.

The Senior years are a time of great transition for our parents or family. Their bodies no longer work as well as they used to, they may have physical or financial limitations that put stress on them. They may have failing memories. They may be dependent on us in ways that we aren't used to experiencing. However, they also carry wisdom which is priceless when shared. Making space for them to share their wisdom gained through the celebrations and challenges of life are treasures to be found. Celebrating the wisdom they carry can help to offset the daily challenges of growing older.

(Suggestion: Consider having a party or gathering to intentionally celebrate a significant birthday or marriage anniversary. We gave my parents a 65th anniversary party that lasted an entire day that included their entire family–kids, grandkids and great grandkids. We had our picture taken, made them a book of their marriage, wrote blessings to share, asked questions about their lives, told them the significant ways they'd impacted our lives, and prayed for them).

### Scriptures:

Exodus 20:12: Honor your father and mother so you will live a long time in the land the Lord your God is giving to you.

Jesus on the cross: Caring for his mother Mary by asking John to take her into his home.

John 19:27: And he said to this disciple, "Here is your mother." And from then on this disciple took her into his home.

Proverbs 1:8: My son, listen when your father corrects you. Don't neglect your mother's instruction. What you learn from them will crown you with grace, and be a chain of honor around your neck.

Hebrews 12:5-11 And have you forgotten his encouraging words spoken to you as his children? He said,

"My child, don't underestimate the value of the discipline and training of the Lord God, or get depressed when he has to correct you. 6 For the Lord's training of your life is the evidence of his faithful love. And when he draws you to himself, it proves you are his delightful child."

7 Fully embrace God's correction as part of your training, for he is doing what any loving father does for his children. For who has ever heard of a child who never had to be corrected? 8 We all should welcome God's discipline as the validation of authentic sonship. For if we have never once endured his correction it only proves we are strangers and not sons.

**9** And isn't it true that we respect our earthly fathers even though they corrected and disciplined us? Then we should demonstrate an even greater respect for God, our spiritual Father, as we submit to his life-giving discipline. **10** Our parents corrected us for the short time of our childhood as it seemed good to them. But God corrects us throughout our lives for our own good, giving us an invitation to share his holiness. **11** Now all discipline seems to be more pain than pleasure at the time, yet later it will produce a transformation of character, bringing a harvest of righteousness and peace to those who yield to it.
